

## Update Barcode Scanner Driver

Step 1 Start--> Search-->Regedit.

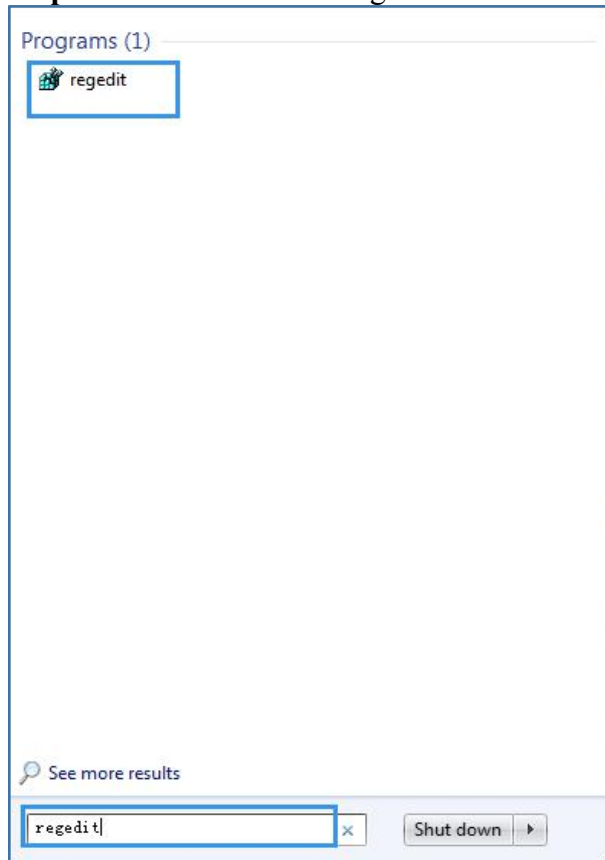

Choose option HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE-->SYSTEM-->Current Control Set-->Control-->Class-->{4D36E96B-E325-11CE-BFC1-08002BE10318}. Check the name and type information should be the same as the information showing in the following figure, and the data should contain kbdclass.

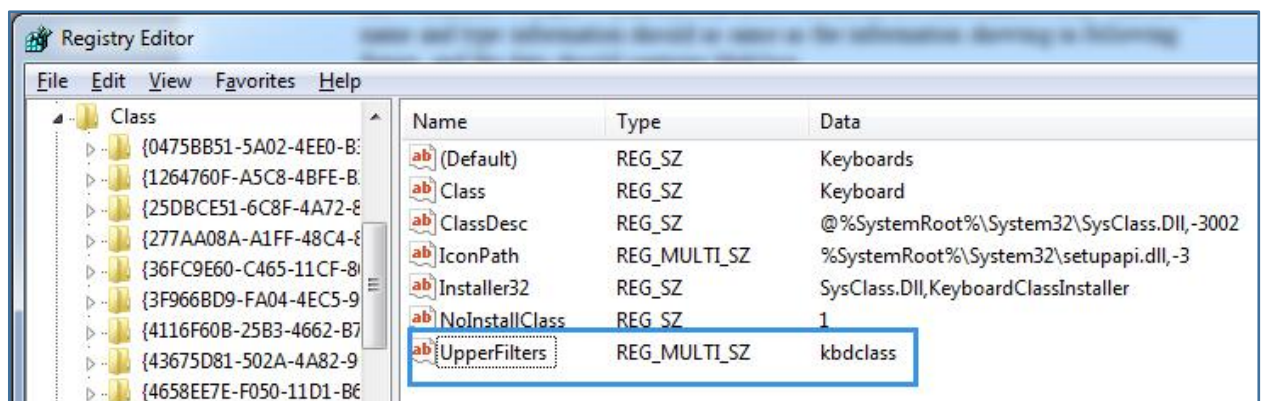

**Step 2** Control Panel--> Device Manager-->Human Interface Device-->HID-compliant device, right click the option, and choose option Update Driver Software.

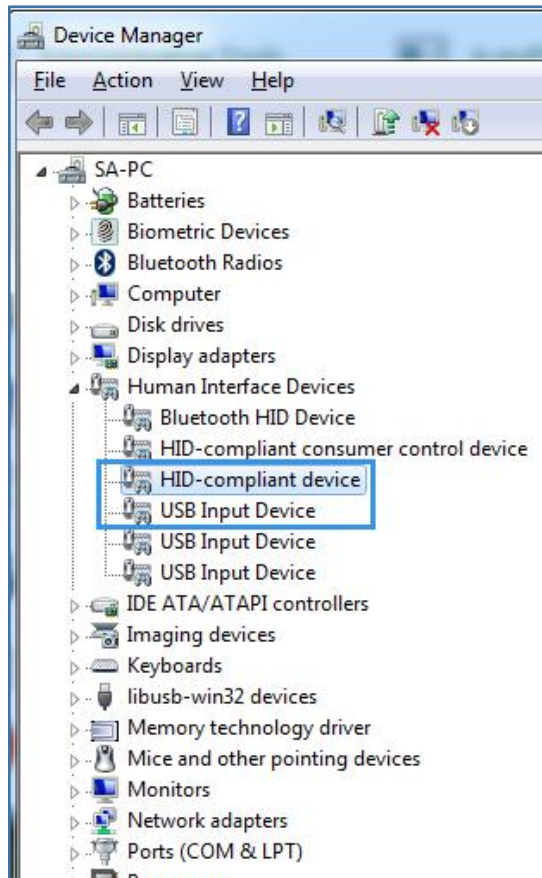

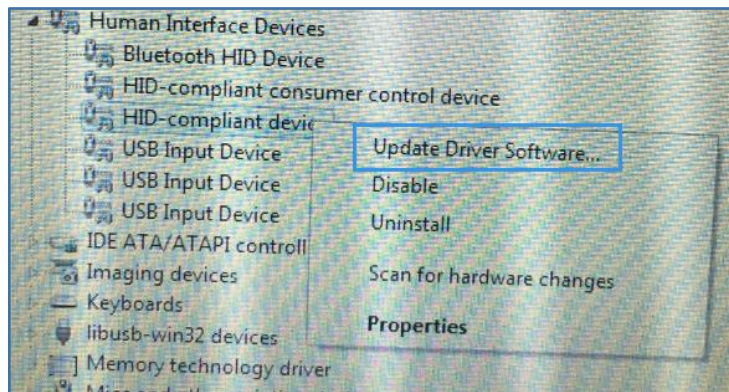

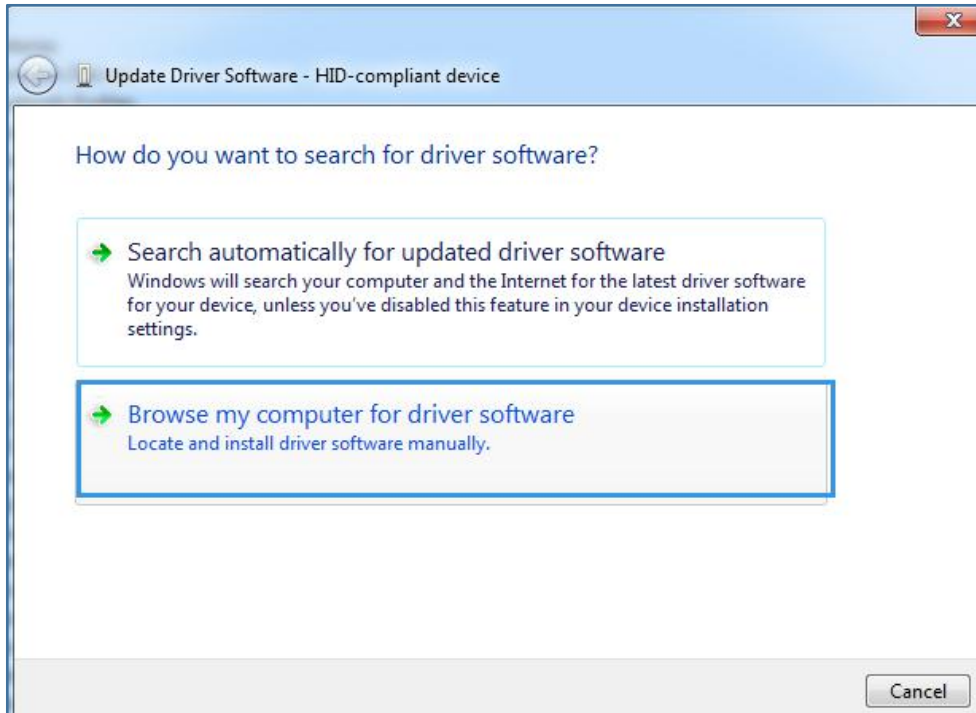

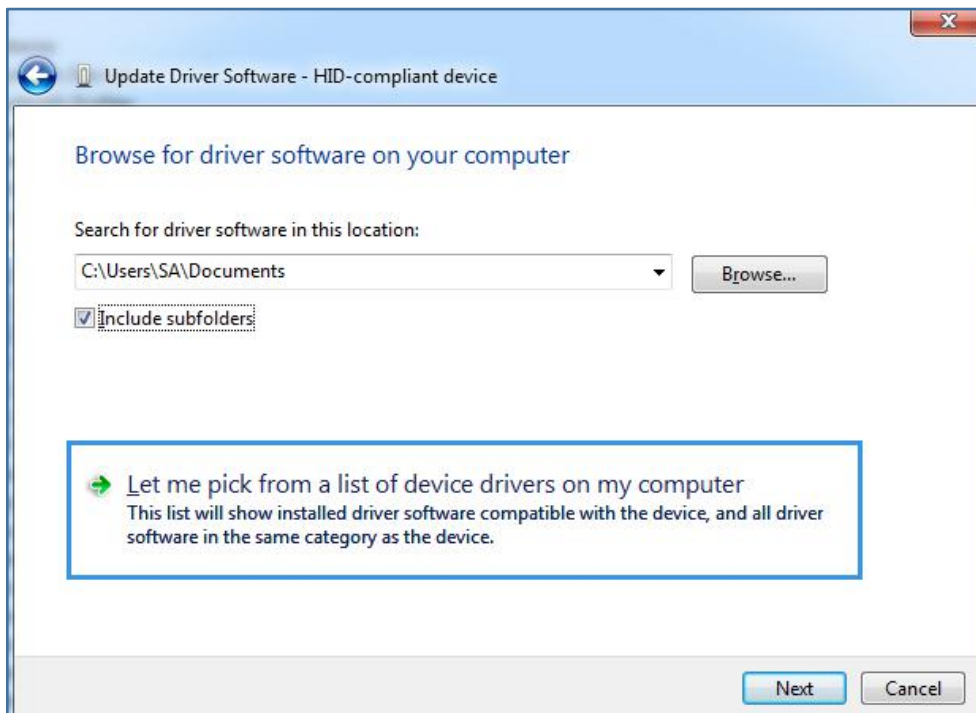

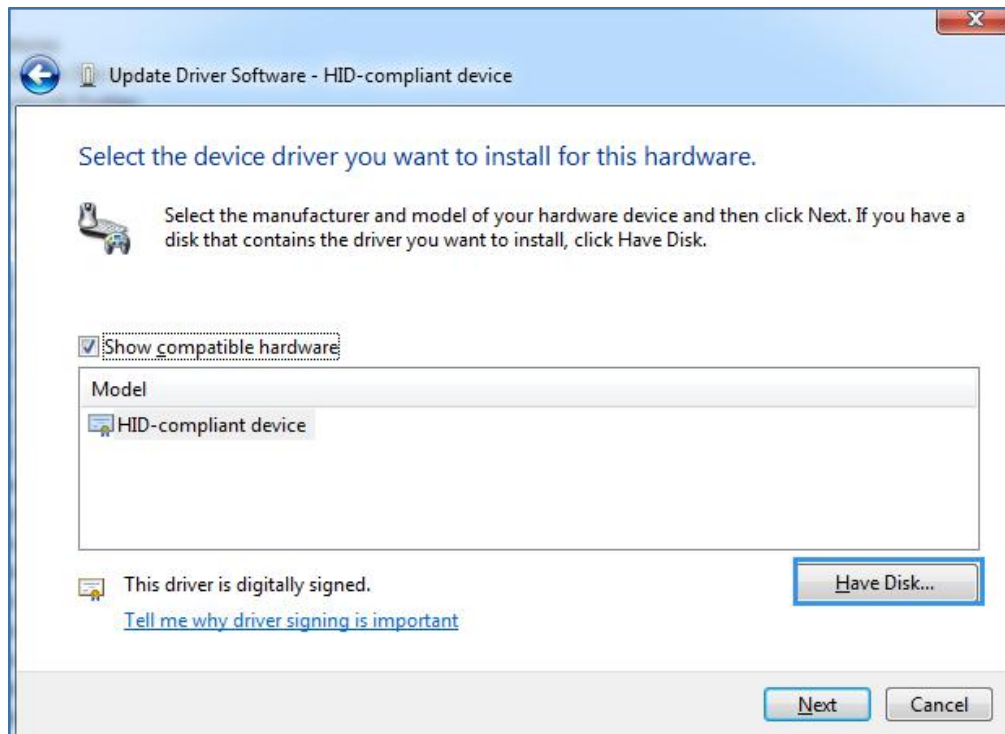

Click Browser, choose update file.

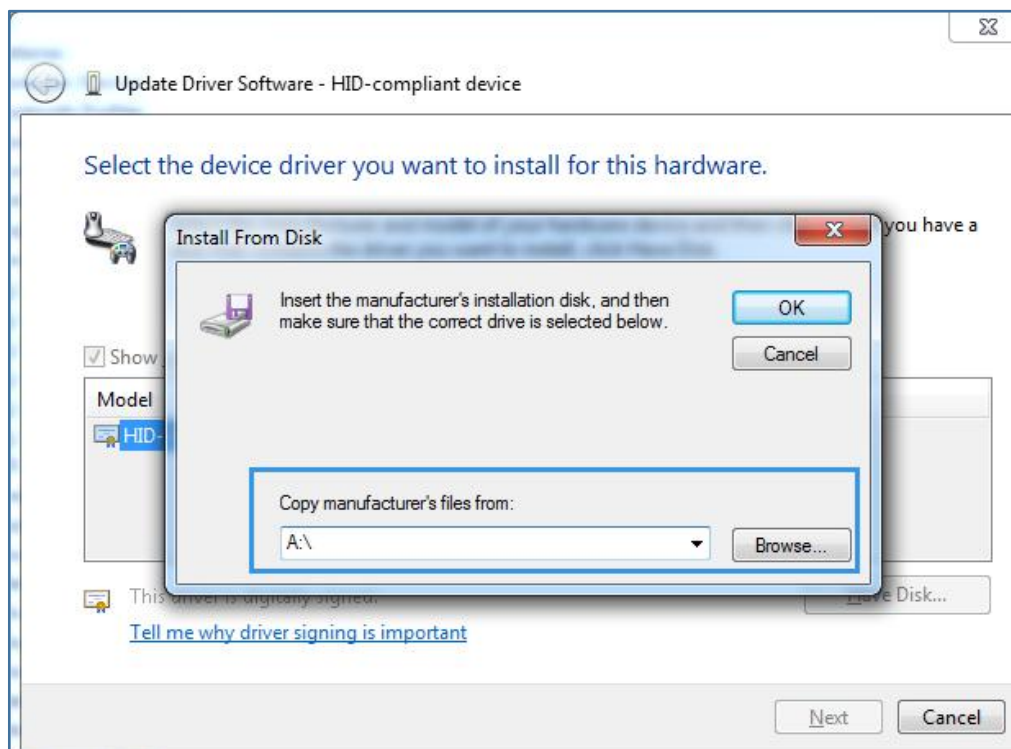

Choose file input.inf\_amd64-->input. Click icon Open, then click icon OK.

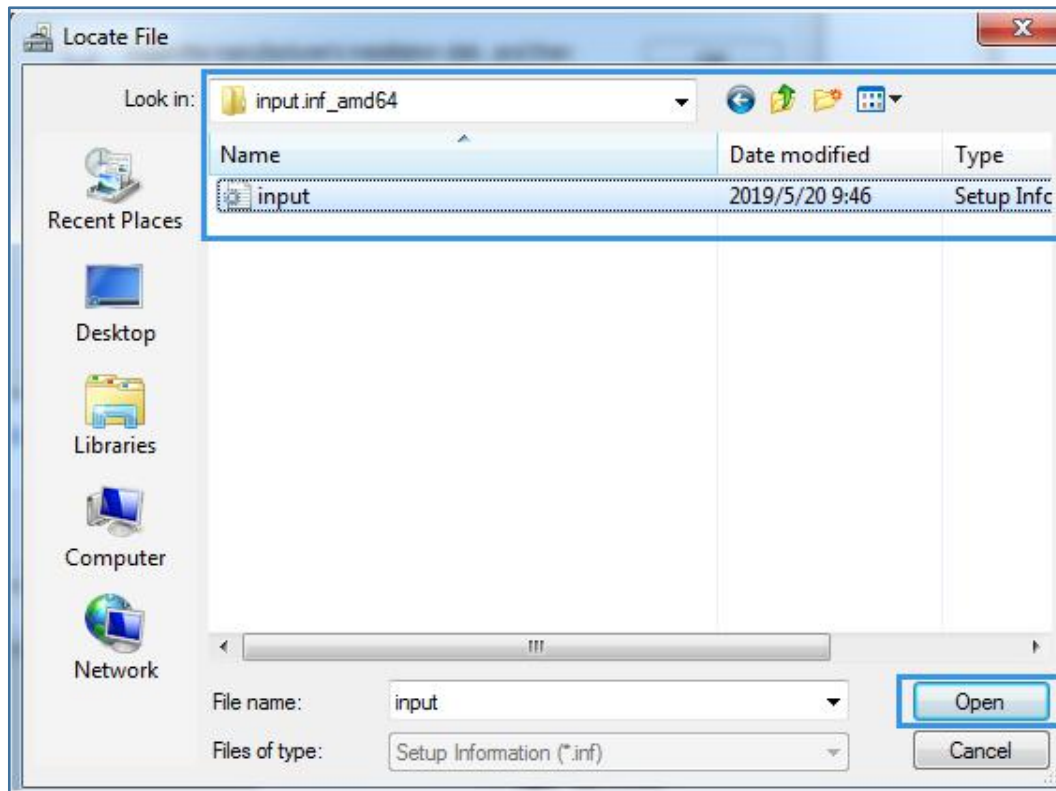

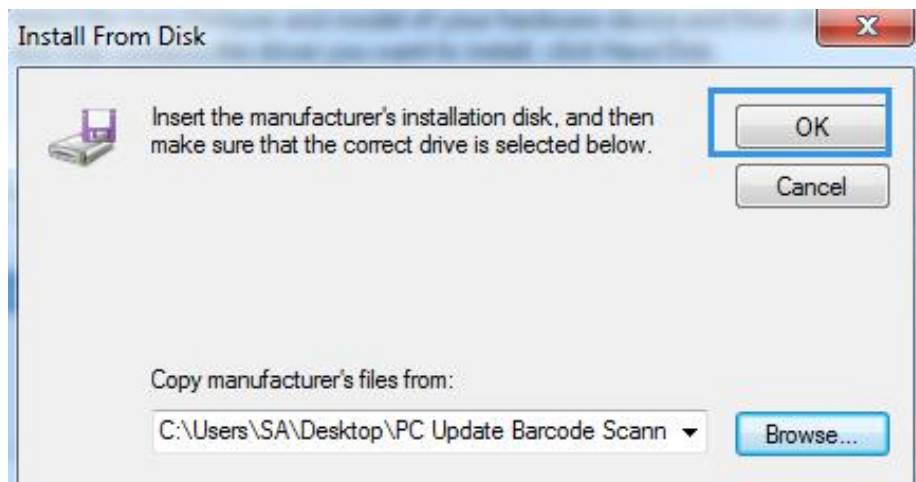

Ignore the prompt message ‘This driver is not digitally signed!’ , click icon Next.

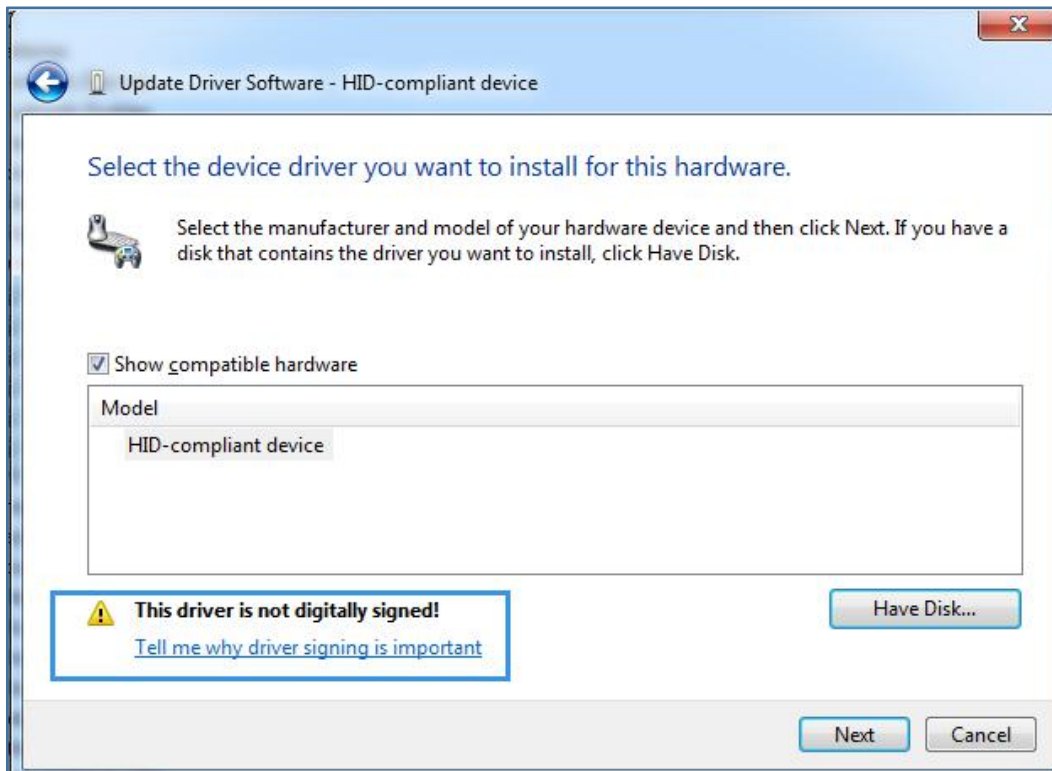

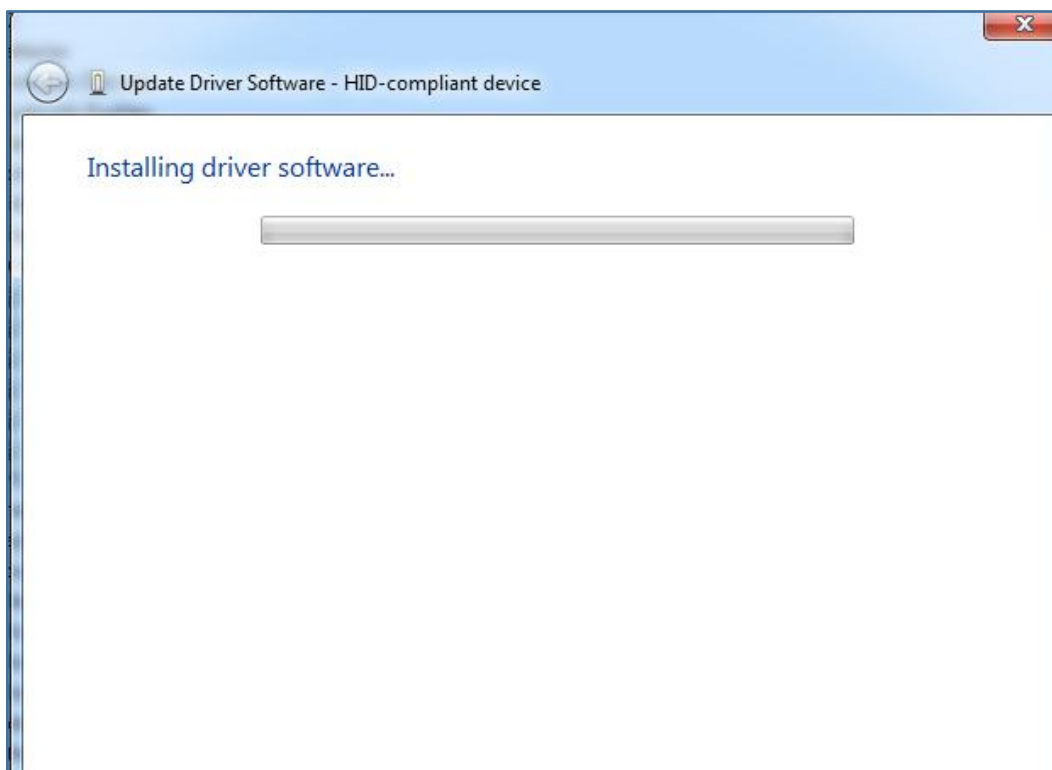

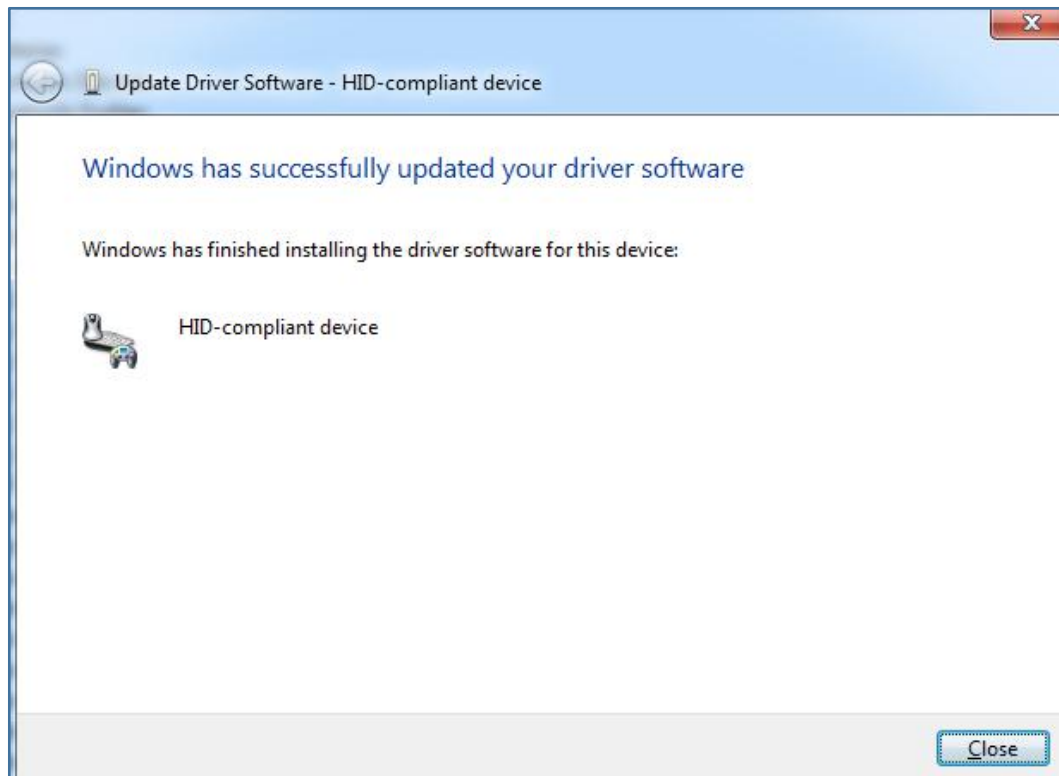

**Step 3** Let the Barcode Scanner connect with PC and check its ID information. Control panel-->Device Manager-->Keyboards-->HID Keyboard Device. If your PC connect with Keyboard and Mouse, PC will has three HID Keyboard Device after the barcode scanner connected with the PC, usually the last one is the device which lastly connect to PC. Right click related option, and choose option Properties.

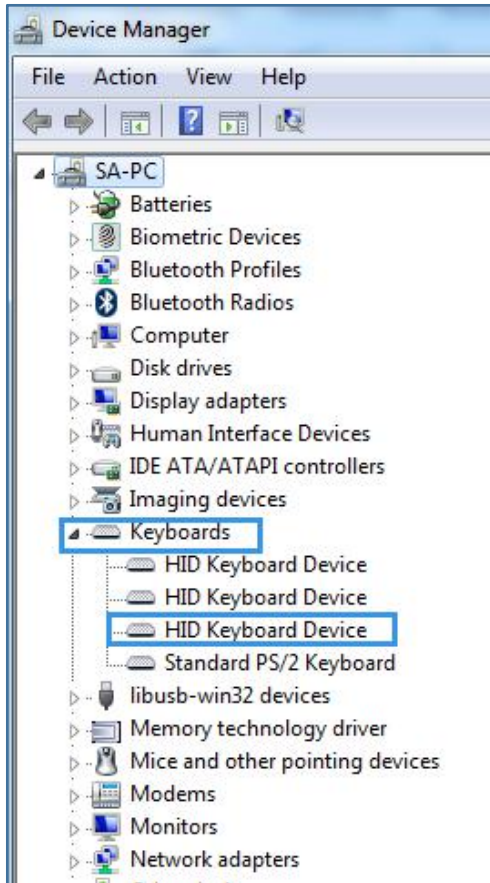

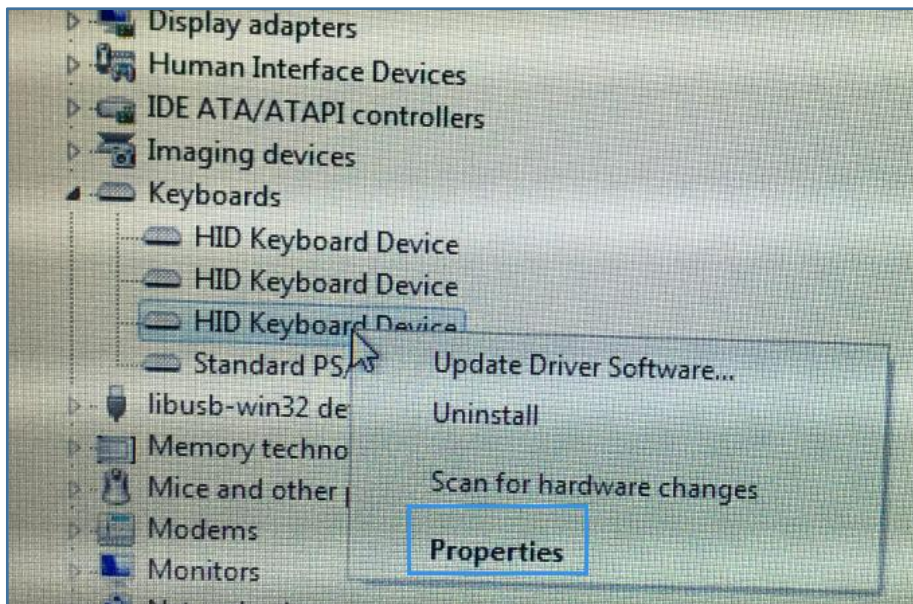

Click icon Details, choose option Hardware Ids, the ID information should be ID\_8003.

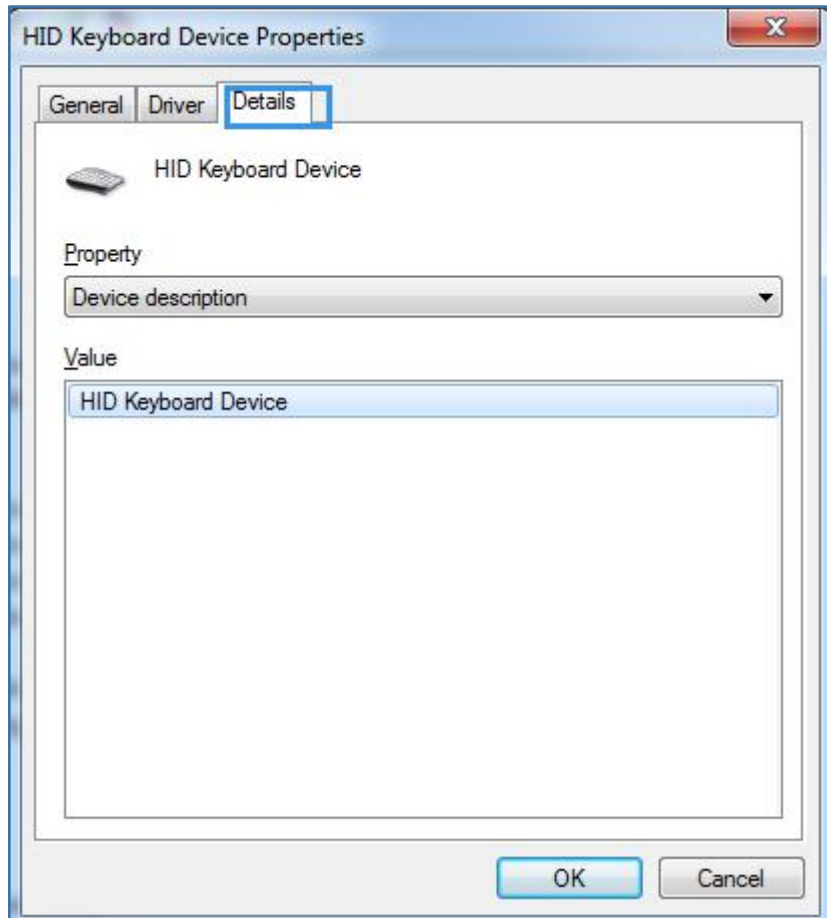

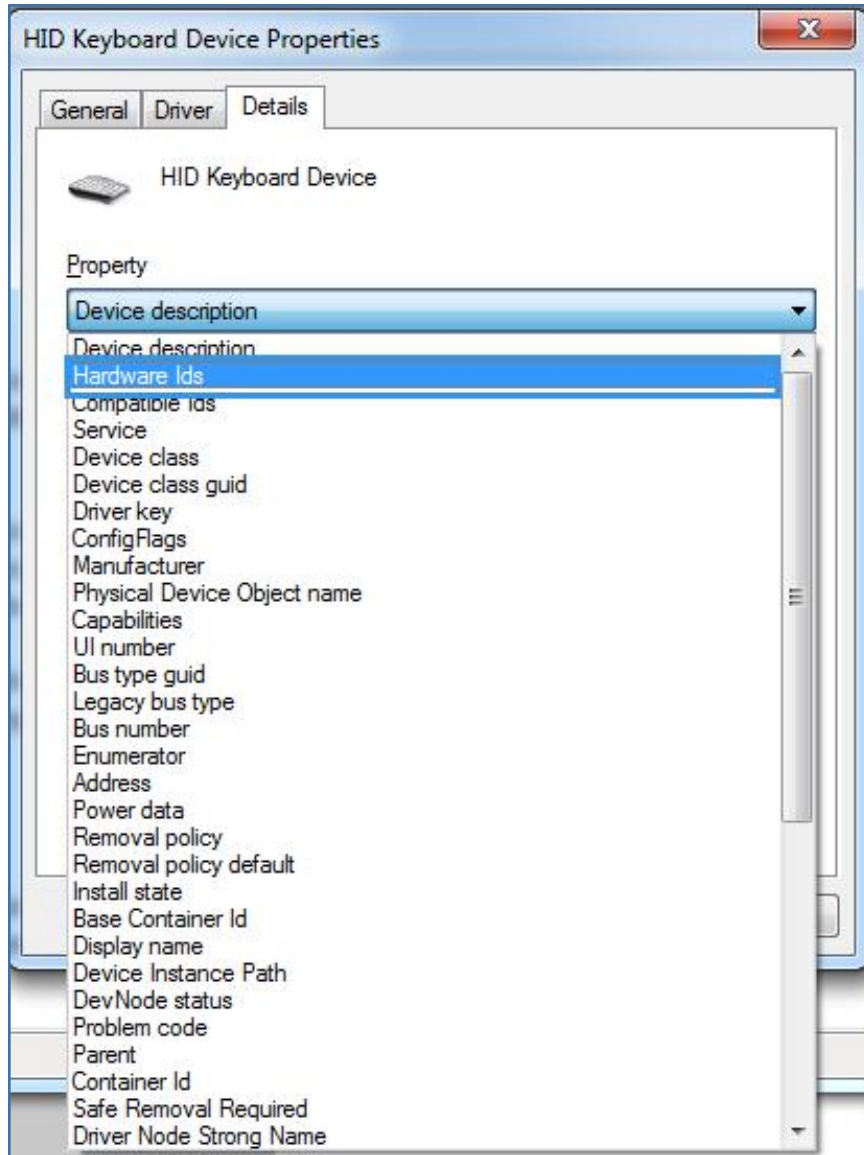

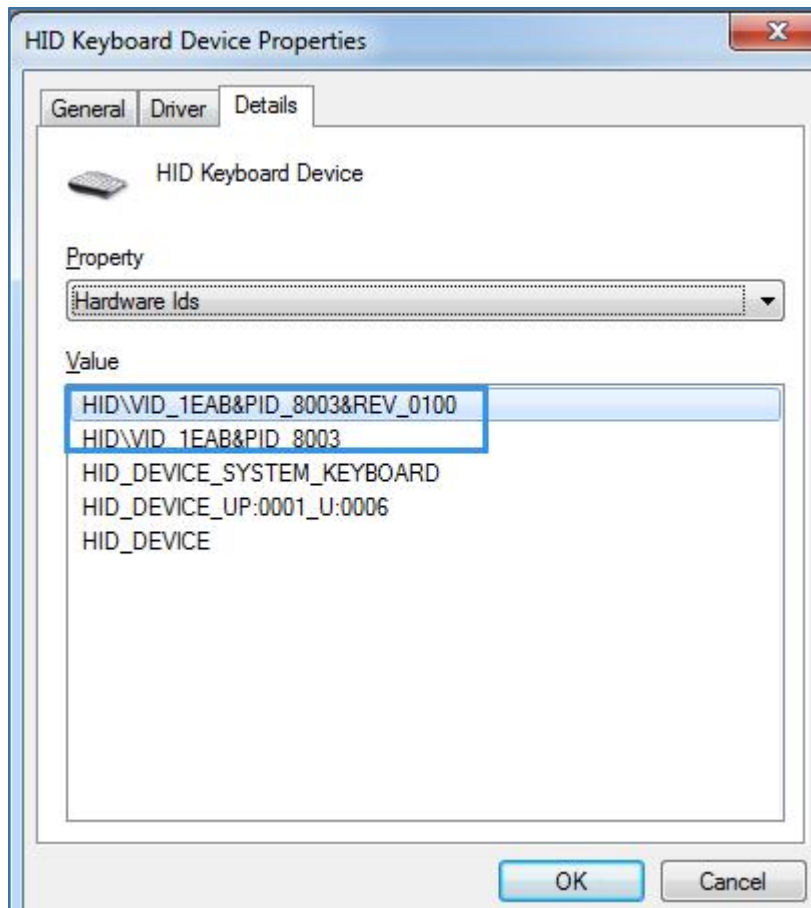
